Assuming China controls the current outbreak, Post forecasts pork production will increase to 55.2 million tons with imports decreasing to 1.2 million metric tons (MMT), a drop of 22 percent. For cattle and beef, consumption demand will continue to outpace domestic production, leading to an 10 percent increase in beef imports at 8.6 MMT.
