International health law brings together international standard-setting instruments adopted in the context of the WHO and under human rights law, while health-related legal rules, norms and other (non-binding) standards can also be found in several other branches of international law, including under international humanitarian and environmental laws, in medical ethics and patients' rights (see also Fig. 1).

Since the entry into force of the International Health Regulations (IHR) in 2007—the international legal instrument that governs the global response to public health threats with potential for international spread—the world has faced six public health emergencies of international concern (PHEICs), including the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
