One of the earliest and most important of the humanists was the Italian poet Francesco Petrarch. Petrarch was born in 1304 not far from Florence. He was a dedicated student of Latin literature and a talented poet. Petrarch wrote part of an epic poem in Latin on the Second Punic War (an episode from Roman history).
