Heliodorus, the author of An Ethiopian Story, claims to be a Phoenician from the Syrian city of Emesa and to belong to the priestly clan of the sun god. He lived during the Roman Empire (probably in the late fourth century ce) and wrote his novel in ancient Greek in an archaic style more characteristic of the writings of Thucydides or Plato (fifth century bce) than the contemporary "common" (koine) form of Greek.
