The first important thing to notice about this chart isn't that it is a bar chart. That isn't very important. Pay attention to the fact that it is showing change over time, from 2007 to 2009. That means that you have to include the general trend in your overview and include vocabulary like 'sharp rise' and 'precipitous drop' throughout.

It is common in the IELTS Writing paper to be asked to describe a bar graph. Bar graphs, also known as bar charts, are similar to line graphs in that they have two axes and are useful for showing how something has changed over a given period of time, especially when there are significant changes.

An IELTS bar chart is different to a chart or table as there aren't usually any key differences to identify. So, as there are no differences to comment on, you should mention, for example, the obvious trend/s AND exception if there is one.
