The primary role of a propagation medium is to provide support and moisture while the plant is developing. These requirements are quite different from those of a potting medium, which may have to sustain a mature or growing plant over a long period of time. Generally speaking, potting media are not recommended for plant propagation purposes.

Step 1: To propagate new plants from most multistemmed houseplants, try rooting tip cuttings. First, cut 4 to 6 inches from the tip of the main stem or side branch.

How to Propagate Plants from Stem Cuttings and Save Lots ...

Also known as vegetative propagation, this method produces new plants by separating vegetative parts (roots, leaves, stems, etc) of the original plant and growing them on. Since they're formed from a single parent, the new plants are clones: genetically identical to the original.

There are tons of plants that you can propagate by cuttings. Shrubby plants are often easiest to start by stem cuttings. Also, some shrubs don't produce true-to-type from seed, so cloning by cuttings might be the only method for making new plants similar to the parent. Herbs like lavender or rosemary grow faster from cuttings than seeds.

Plants can be propagated from cuttings or by dividing at any time of the year but be aware that roots form much more slowly during winter months. If you are in a very cold climate, indoor propagation is the only suitable method during the depths of winter. Avoid woody or hard plant pieces when cutting or dividing.

Propagation, in horticulture, the reproduction of plants by any number of natural or artificial means. With crops that produce seed freely and come true closely enough for the purposes in view, growing from seed usually is the cheapest and most satisfactory method of plant propagation.

We call this process vegetative propagation. When exposed to the right conditions the cuttings will develop new roots and grow into a new plant. Growing From Seeds: The pollen of the male plant pollinates the female organs, and the result is seeds. Seeds are basically a tiny plant, an embryo so to speak.

How to Propagate Plants in Water - the Easy Way to Make ...

Plants that grow from bulbs can be propagated by taking small offsets or bulblets from the base of the parent bulb. Place the bulblets in light, rich soil and let develop for 2 or 3 years. The same procedure used for propagating bulbs works for plants with corms (see "What is a Plant Corm?").
