Aetiology Risk factors for suicide [9, 10, 11]. Previous suicide attempt or previous self-harm. Self-harm is associated with a significantly higher risk of death and much of this is from suicide [2, 12]. A history of self-harm is present in up to three quarters of women who die from suicide, and more than that in those under the age of 25.

This applies in particular to people who present after a suicide attempt or an episode of self-harm, with probable mental illness or dual diagnosis, or after a recent discharge from a psychiatric inpatient unit,

Listing all the elements to a suicide risk assessment is outside the scope of this article, but the goal behind any risk assessment is analogous to that of an inductive process, that being to gather data about suicide risk indicators, risk and protective factors, and functional patterns to ultimately inform management and intervention approaches in a highly individualized fashion.

The standard of care in suicide risk assessment requires that clinicians conduct thorough suicide risk assessments when patients screen positive for suicide risk and then make reasonable formulations of risk.¹
